5. Emergency Management Update:

- The Director of Administration and Emergency Measures Officer reached out to all displaced community members today. Most are back home with no/minimal damage other than spoiled food. One home was a total loss.
- The fire station at 2050 Hammonds Plains Road is distributing well water testing kits to residents in the evacuation zones.
- ISC inquired about our comfort center plans. They have been advised that it is still in the planning development stage, and they will be updated when quotes are received.



- A replacement unit for the loss in Hammonds Plains is estimated to take 6 weeks with a 20% downpayment.
- Fire bans are still in effect until June 25th, 2023.
