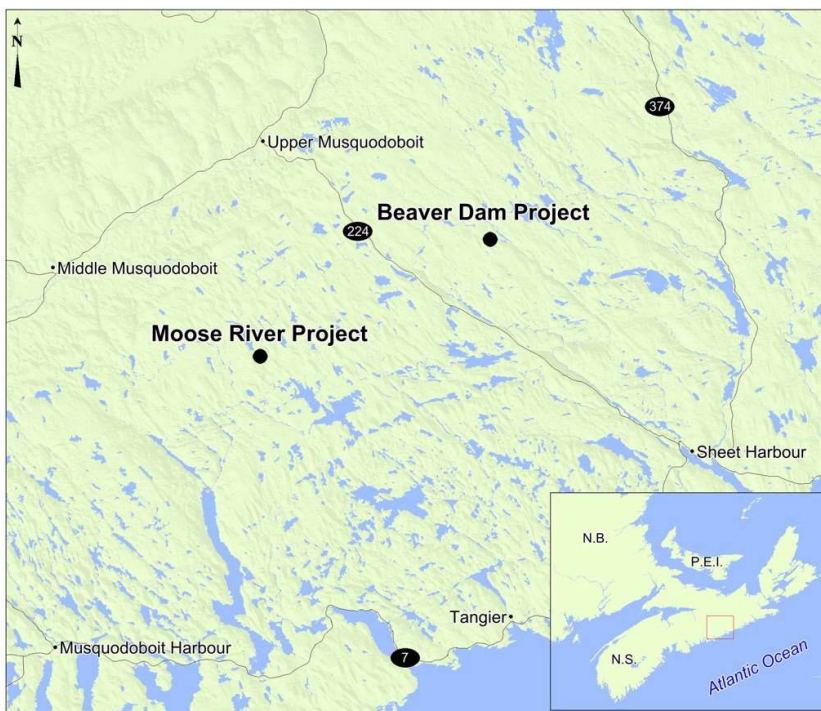

Atlantic Gold is pleased to invite Sipekne'katik Band members to the Community Open House to review information on the planned start of construction of the permitted Touquoy Gold Mine and the commencement of the Environmental Assessment processes for the Beaver Dam Gold Mine.



These two gold deposits are part of Atlantic Gold's Moose River Consolidated Project.

- The mining of the Touquoy deposit will occur for approximately five years.
- If successfully permitted, the mining of the Beaver Dam deposit would follow for three to four years.
- Gold ore mined from Beaver Dam is proposed to be trucked to and processed at the Touquoy site using existing facilities.

During construction, employment will peak at 300 people primarily with contractors. Jobs created during operation are expected to be about 150 for Touquoy and 215 for Beaver Dam.
